



This report submitted to the Commissioners Court of Jack County this the 23rd day of January, 2012.

The Jack County Sheriff's Office conducted 434 traffic stops from 01-01-2011 to 12-31-2011 issuing a total of 223 citations, 211 written warnings.

The percentages of traffic stops by race are as follows:

White = 92.50 % of traffic stops. Black = 2.75% of traffic stops. Hispanic = 4.06 of traffic stops. Asian = .69% of traffic stops Other Race = 0.0% of traffic stops.

There were a total of 38 vehicles searched in conjunction to the traffic stops.

There have been no reports or complaints filed against any member of the Jack County Sheriff's Office regarding the use of Racial Profiling in this 2011 reporting period.
