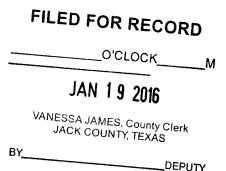

PAYMENT OF ACCOUNTS AND CLAIMS

All accounts and claims were submitted to the Court for approval. Those submitted were approved and entered into the computer of the County Treasurer.

Commissioner Umphress made a motion to pay all the bills. Commissioner Brock seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

CONSENT AGENDA ITEMS

The following items were taken up under the Consent Agenda:

- (a) Approval of Minutes of Meetings of January 9, 2017;
- (b) Review and Acceptance of Treasurer's and Auditor's Monthly Reports for period ending December 31, 2016;
- (c) Reception of Certificates of Training Hours for Elected/Appointed County Official/Officer: Michael Hardy, Deputy Sheriff; and Thomas Spurlock, Sheriff;
- (d) Approval of annual assistance under Contract for Services or Interlocal Agreement to Wise County for shared expenses in operation of the 271st Judicial District (\$52,808);
- (e) Adoption of Proclamation declaring Friday, February 3, 2017, as National Wear Red Day in Jack County;

Judge Davenport made a motion to adopt the consent agenda. Commissioner Birdwell seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

COMMISSIONER PRECINCT OPERATIONS

Discussion was made between the Court about different ideas and projects they have going in their precincts.

COURTHOUSE REPAIR PROJECT 2016 AND 2017

Judge Davenport reported that the flooring has been put down in the Treasurer's Office. When the Treasurer's office is complete the Judge's Office will be done next. The Judge's office will be moving up to the 3rd floor to the old probation office while the work is being done in their office.

CTIF GRANT AND FEMA FLOOD GRANT

Court members discussed among themselves and with the Auditor and Treasurer the status of completion, administration, and billing in the CTIF grant through TxDOT and FEMA Flood Grant (2015). Discussed how much is left on the CTIF reimbursement to date. Requested \$918,000 out of \$1.4 million, also discussed the status of FEMA reimbursement.

DEPARTMENT HEADS

The Court talked with Frank Hefner that does IT work for the County about progress at the Law Enforcement Center. Mr. Hefner also gave information regarding Emergency Management. Constable Watson informed the Court that law enforcement in the County had been very busy and the County Court will be very busy soon.

CONSIDER EXTENDING/ADOPTING GUIDELINES AND CRITERIA FOR GOVERNMENT TAX ABATEMENT AGREEMENTS

Judge Davenport spoke to the Court about the Tax Abatement plan the County has used in the past that has now expired and presented a copy of a proposed order if the Court wanted to extend or renew the previous order.

Motion was made by Commissioner Ward, seconded by Judge Davenport to enact the proposed order. The motion carried and the executed Order will be attached to the minutes of the Court.

CONSIDER ENTERING INTO NEGOTIATIONS WITH THE CITY OF JACKSBORO FOR THE DISPOSITION OF USED TIRE WASTE

Jacksboro City Manager, Mike Smith addressed the Court regarding a contract the City is in to dispose of tires. In the City when tires are found dumped in ditches or empty lots they have a contract with a company that brings in a trailer to the convenience center outside of town the city employees put them in the trailer and when it is full the waste company comes with another trailer and hauls the full trailer off. Mr. Smith thought this program might be beneficial for the County to participate in also and that the City and County might be able to partner in the program.

Motion was made to carry on further discussion about making an Interlocal agreement with the City of Jacksboro in this matter. Motion received a second from Judge Davenport. The vote in the matter was 3 for and 2 against the motion carried.

CONSIDER ACTION TO SUPPORT COMMUNITY BLOCK DEVELOPMENT GRANT BY THE CITY OF BRYSON THROUGH NORTEX FOR 2018 TO PROVIDE IN KIND MATCH OF UP TO \$13,750 FOR A SEWER REPLACEMENT GRANT

City of Bryson Secretary, Frank Hefner addressed the Court regarding a grant the City of Bryson will be applying for to support Community Block Development to replace the sewer. He would like to see if the County would enter an agreement for force labor and an in kind match of up to \$13,750 for a sewer replacement.

Motion was made by Commissioner Birdwell to enter an agreement for an in kind match. Motion received a second from Commissioner Umphress and passed unanimously.

CONSIDER MEASURE PROPOSED BY THE COUNTY CLERK TO HIRE PART TIME/TEMPORARY PART TIME PERSON TO BE PAID FROM RECORDS MANAGEMENT FUND APPROVED FOR 20 HOURS A WEEK

County Clerk, Vanessa James would like the Court to approve her to hire an individual to scan in and archive documents, cases and other records in the Clerk's Office to be paid out of the Clerk's Records Management Fund.

Notion was made by Commissioner Birdwell for the Clerk to be able to hire temporary / part time employee paid out of the Records Management Fund but they should not exceed 30 hours per week. Motion received a second from Commissioner Umphress and passed unanimously.

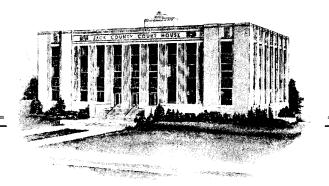

A RESOLUTION OF THE JACK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS'COURT ADOPTING GUIDELINES AND CRITERIA GOVERNING TAX ABATEMENT AGREEMENTS BY THE COUNTY OF JACK, TEXAS

WHEREAS, Texas Tax Code Section 312.002 provides that no municipality or county may designate an area as a reinvestment zone, and that no taxing unit may execute a tax abatement agreement under Texas Tax Code chapter 312, unless it first (i) establishes guidelines and criteria for tax abatement agreements and (ii) adopts a resolution stating that the taxing unit elects to become eligible to participate in tax abatement; and

W'HEREAS, the County of Jack, Texas, desires to be eligible to participate in tax abatement under certain circumstances; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF JACK COUNTY, TEXAS THAT

ARTICLE I.

Jack County, Texas elects to be eligible to participate in tax abatement.

ARTICLE II

The following guidelines and criteria were previously established, are hereby established and shall hereafter govern tax abatement agreements by the County of Jack, Texas:

- 1. Improvements proposed as part of a tax abatement agreement for property located within a duly designated reinvestment zone shall be commenced within two (2) years of the date designated in said agreement.
- 2. All construction proposed, as part of any such improvements, shall meet applicable County of Jack, Texas, Codes and Zoning requirements.
- 3. All property included in a tax abatement shall be maintained in accordance with all applicable County of Jack, Texas, Codes and Zoning requirements during the term of the tax abatement agreement.
- 4. Throughout tax abatement agreement, the owner(s) or persons in possession and control of the improvements located thereon which is included within an area which is the subject of a tax abatement agreement shall pay all lawfully assessed ad valorem taxes levied on such property before the same shall become delinquent.
- 5. For property located in a commercial and/or industrial reinvestment zone, and proposed as the subject of a tax abatement agreement, the following criteria shall apply:
 - a. The proposed improvements must have the effect of increasing the value of the real property upon which they are located; and,
 - b. The proposed improvements shall have the effect of adding to the available number of jobs and/or retaining existing jobs in the greater Jack County, Texas area.

- 6. For residential property located in a residential reinvestment zone, and proposed as the subject of a tax abatement agreement, the following criteria shall apply:
 - a. The proposed improvements shall address the blighting or deteriorating influences on the subject property;
 - b. The proposed improvements shall address building safety, unsanitary or unsafe conditions, or property deterioration; and
 - c. Where applicable, the improvements shall address faulty lot layout with respect to size, accessibility, or usefulness.
- 7. All improvements proposed, as part of a tax abatement agreement, shall further the purposes established by the Legislature of the State of Texas in Chapter 312 of the Texas Tax Code.
- 8. In accordance with Texas Tax Code section 312.002, these guidelines and criteria shall not limit the discretion of the County to decide whether to enter into a specific tax abatement agreement. Accordingly, the County may enter into a particular tax abatement agreement whenever it determines that it is in the best interests of the County to enter into such agreement and provide such abatement with respect to a particular applicant, In doing so, the County may vary from the provisions of this Tax Abatement Policy Statement in any respect that is not contrary to state law.

ARTICLE III

This resolution shall be effective from its adoption on January 23, 2017, for the full period authorized by law.
