PRECINCT RADIO SYSTEM STUDY GROUP

Frank Hefner reported on the status of the precinct Radio System Study Group. He said that he filed an application with the FCC for public works frequency. No action can take place until this is approved, then he will know what steps to take next.

WARNING SYSTEM FOR TORNADO THREAT BY JACK COUNTY DEM AND POLICY/PRACTICE OF SAME

Emergency Management Coordinator Frank Hefner talked about the I-Info system and the recent tornado warning that went out to Jack County locals via phone calls. He demonstrated the program to Commissioners and showed them how messages are sent out and how alerts can be sent to the whole county or certain areas of the county. He also discussed reverse 911 calls and demonstrated. He told Commissioners that if something is going on at the edge of another

county, alerts will also go to that County's Department of Emergency Management. This site is registered with the State and the cost is about \$1,500 per year per license. The County's DEM has one and the Sheriff's Department. This system can be used for all local news, road closures and election updates.

CONSIDER REQUEST BY THE CITY OF JACKSBORO FOR TRANSFER OF 1.0 ACRE TRACT OF THE E. BRUTON SURVEY, ABSTRACT NO. 43 TO THE CITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF BUILDING AN ANIMAL SHELTER AND REJECTION OF OFFER ON SAME ROPERTY BY TAB SIMS FOR PRICEOF \$5,200

Starr Kinder reported to Commissioners that the current animal shelter is too small and not in a convenient location. The Friends of the Shelter has been raising money and there is a grant which would go toward building a new facility. Karen Umphress and Kim Gibby spoke up in favor of going forward with this project and reported it would be beneficial to have highway frontage. They would like to keep the current shelter as a quarantine facility and build a larger new animal shelter.

Commissioner Birdwell made a motion to transfer the property to the City of Jacksboro for the purpose of building a new animal shelter and reject the offer by Tab Simms subject to affirmation by the agreement of the other taxing entities in the county involved. Commissioner Ward seconded. Commissioner Berry amended the motion to state that this would be subject to confirmation by the other entities who would receive funds from this sale. All were for the amendment and the motion carried (5-0).

APPROVAL OF ADDITIONAL FUNDS TO SUPPORT GOVERNOR'S EGRANT FUNDS IN PURCHASE OF SHERIFF'S OFFICE SAFETY EQUIPMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$799.98

Chief Deputy Mike Hardy told Commissioners the grant is for new Ballistic Vests for the Sheriff's Department and Constable. There will be a total of 17 new vests which will include carriers and plates.

Commissioner Berry made a motion to approve the additional funds necessary of \$799.98 to be taken out of Courthouse Security funds. Commissioner Brock seconded and the motion passed (5-0).

PAYMENT OF OFF DUTY GUARD FEES FOR LEC ROOF PROJECT

Chief Deputy Mike Hardy told Commissioner that off-duty personnel were used briefly on the LEC roof repair project and will need to be paid. TAC recommended they bring it before the Commissioners for approval. The Commissioners Court expressed its opinion that this was a matter between the contractor and the individuals. No action will be taken on this as the project manager Mr. Snow (contractor rep) will need to get with Judge Davenport to discuss the matter.

Judge Davenport made a motion to table the item at this time. Commissioner Ward seconded and the motion passed (5-0).

REVIEW OF JACK COUNTY APPRAISAL DISTRICT 2018 PRELIMINARY VALUES, REFUNDS OF TAXES ON LEASED COMPRESSOR EQUIPMENT UNDER STATEWIDE LITIGATION, AND 2018 BRAZOS ELECTRIC JACK COUNTY GENERATION EVALUATION ISSUES

Judge Davenport gave Commissioners an update on the litigation and informed the Court that depending on the outcome of the Court of Appeals litigation, refunds may have to be issued. No action was taken.

CONSIDER ADJUSTMENT OF JOB DESCRIPTION FOR MAINTENANCE/CUSTODIAN SUPERVISOR

AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY JUDGE TO ADVERTISE FOR PUBLIC HEARING TO SET A MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT ON ALL COUNTY ROADS AND RATIFY/APPROVE MINIMUM STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS ON SONSTRUCTION OF COUNTY ROADS

Commissioner Brock made a motion to table the advertisement of setting a maximum speed limit on all county roads but to approve/ratify advertising to conduct a hearing to set/ratify minimum

standards and specification on construction of county roads. Commissioner Birdwell seconded and the motion passed (4-1), with Commissioner Berry voting against.

DEPARTMENT HEADS

Building Maintenance Supervisor Lane Argo told Commissioner that the inspectors recently checked the boiler system and it passed inspection. He also reported that the State is developing with stricter regulations regarding boilers within the next 2 years and the County may have to consider other heating options in the years to come. A plumber has been repairing lines on the southwest corner of the building in the restroom and will also be repairing outside.

Commissioner Berry will be bringing a load of dirt to fill holes in the yard before the upcoming fish fry.

Sheriff Spurlock reported having a partial list ready for the upcoming County Auction. He also told Commissioners this next week is National Police Memorial Week. Law Enforcement will place a wreath on the grave of Sheriff William M. King who was killed in the line of duty on July 17, 1885.
