Commissioner Oliver reported that he has still been working on both ends of Green Elm road.

REPORTS BY OTHER DEPARTMENT HEADS

Maintenance Supervisor, Lane Argo reported that he had a new water cutoff installed on an outside wall of the Courthouse. He also reported that the plumbers were about to begin repairs to the restrooms at the North end of the building. There is a cutoff to that so he will not have to turn water off to the entire building.

There have been lighting issues in the Justice of the Peace Office, so Lane changed out the ballist and added new fluorescent bulbs which made a major difference. He would like to have these in the entire courthouse.

Sharon Robinson told Commissioner that the Election Committee met and interviewed applicants on Wednesday, January 23, 2019. Lynn Casteel was chosen as the new Election Administrator for Jack County to begin training February 9, 2019 with elections officially turned over to her on May 10, 2019.

County Auditor Lisa Perry reported to Commissioners that all auction items from the recent County auction have been paid for with total earnings of \$129,840.29. There are still a few items that need to be picked up.

Sheriff Spurlock told the Commissioners that the computer system they had been checking into ended up being much more than was originally quoted to them so they have checked with Co-Logic which will cost much less but will provide the services needed. The first year would be covered by a grant, the second year the company would cover the cost and the third year it would cost the County \$18,000. He also reported issues with the sewage system at the LEC which will need to be repaired or replaced. The cost would be anywhere from \$7,500 to \$15,000.

The exterior lighting at the LEC is needing attention. Lane Argo is having Miller Electric look at it and give an estimate to replace all bulbs.
