#### EMERGENCY MEETING CALLED REGARDING PERRIN WATER SITUATION

Notice was posted last night and emailed to the media so the 1 hour media notice was met. Regional EM director Lance Liggett was present at today's meeting. Commissioners met to discuss the severity of the water situation in Perrin and try to find a resolution.

Commissioner Brock spoke with TCEQ last night and let them know that both pumps are out to the Perrin water supply so there is no water for the Community. There is an interested party who would like to take over but they are waiting on the State to let them know if there are funds available to begin the repair process.

Commissioners discussed providing each household with 3 gallon bottles of water and having a central location where families can pick up the bottles.
