UPDATE ON LONG TERM DISASTER RECOVERY EFFORTS DUE TO THE MARCH 21, 2022 TORNADO

Beginning the final stage of the recovery process, they have recommended 5 homes to the Mennonite group. They have met with the Amish workers that will be coming to do the work on the homes. Work will begin the week after Thanksgiving.
