Commissioner Birdwell made a motion to approve the execution of the "<u>Notice of Special Election</u>" to be signed by the County Judge and an "<u>Order of Special Election</u>" to be signed by the County Judge and Commissioners for the Election to be held on November 4, 2025. Commissioner Ward seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously. (4-0)

APPROVAL AND AUTHORIZATION FOR COUNTY JUDGE TO SIGN PROPOSED JOINT ELECTION AGREEMENT AND CONTRACT FOR ELECTION SERVICES BETWEEN JACK COUNTY, BOWIE ISD AND PERRIN-WHITT CISD FOR THE NOVEMBER 4, 2025, ELECTION

Commissioner Birdwell made a motion to authorize the County Judge to sign the proposed <u>Joint Election Agreement</u> and Contract for Election Services between Jack County, Bowie ISD, and Perrin-Whitt CISD for the November 4, 2025, Election. Commissioner Oliver seconded the motion.

Judge Umphress amended the motion to authorize the County Judge to sign the proposed Joint Election Agreement and Contract for Election Services between Jack County and Perrin-Whitt CISD. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Ward and passed unanimously. (4-0)
