Motion was made by Judge Umphress to approve payment of the bill submitted by Timekeeper. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Oliver, and it passed unanimously. (5-0)

Motion was made by Commissioner Birdwell to accept the <u>bid</u> provided by Zack Burkett for crushed rock and road building material for use by the Commissioners for FY2025-2026. Commissioner Salazar seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously. (5-0)

DISCUSS AND ACCEPT THE RE-PLAT OF THE "MESQUITE ESTATES" SUBDIVISION LOCATED IN PRECINCT #3, JACK COUNTY, TEXAS

Motion was made by Commissioner Birdwell to approve the replat of the Mesquite Estates subdivision located in Precinct #3. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Ward, and it passed unanimously. (5-0)

Motion was made by Commissioner Ward to approve and authorize the County Judge to sign the proposed Joint Election <u>Agreement</u> and Contract for Election Services between Jack County and Bowie ISD for the November 4, 2025, Election.
