(b) Acceptance of the Application for "Abel's Place Subdivision" from J&A Home and Land, LLC, being 148.91 acres situated in the H. Martinez Survey, Abstract #282, located in Precinct #1, Jack County, Texas;

Judge Umphress made a motion to approve the presented Consent Agenda Items, striking item (b) as an error. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Ward and passed unanimously. (4-0)

REVIEW AND CONSIDER THE RECOMMENDATION FROM THE BENEFITS ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO APPROVE THE PROVIDER FOR DENTAL, VISION, AND MEDICAL INSURANCE FOR OCTOBER 1, 2025, TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2026;

Frank Hefner updated the Court about the most recent information the Benefits Advisory Committee has received and the committee's recommendation to stay with United Healthcare, raise our deductible \$6,750, and add in another Nonstop plan. Each member will receive a Mastercard with the deductible amount that can be used only for deductibles, except for an ER visit that will cost \$100.

Commissioner Birdwell made a motion to approve the recommendation from the Benefits Advisory Committee to stay with United Healthcare Insurance and add a Nonstop plan. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Ward, and it passed unanimously. (4-0)

Commissioner Birdwell made a motion to approve Jack County's becoming a Foreign Trade Zone designation. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Oliver and passed unanimously. (4-0)

CONTINUATION OF CURRENT \$10 (STATUTORY MAXIMUM) CHARGE ON VEHICLE REGISTRATION FOR BENEFIT OF ROAD AND BRIDGE FUND AND ELECTION TO NOT ASSESS A CHILD SAFETY FEE OF \$1.50 MAXIMUM; BOTH UNDER CHAPTER 502, TRANSPORTATION CODE FOR FY 2025-2026

Commissioner Ward made a motion to continue collecting the current \$10 charge on vehicle registration for the benefit of the Road and Bridge Fund and elect not to assess a Child Safety Fee of \$1.50 maximum. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Birdwell and passed unanimously. (4-0)
