Discussion made, no action taken.


FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS

Consider payment of invoice submitted from Bob Bass Attorney.


ADJOURNMENT

The meeting was adjourned at 11:20 a.m.






Gary Oliver, Commissioner Pct. #1
