WHO WE ARE

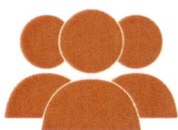
Our mission is to empower child abuse victims, their families, and our community through education, healing, and justice.

Children's Advocacy Center for North Texas and our partners are the front-line responders to reports of child abuse in Denton County, Wise County, and Jack County. We are the only non-profit organization that uses a coordinated, multi-disciplinary approach to address child abuse cases, providing education, healing, and justice to children, families, and our community. Our Multi-Disciplinary Team (MDT) includes prosecutorial teams in all three counties, law enforcement and Department of Family and Protective Services investigators, medical personnel and our staff. In 2025, we served **4,672 clients**.

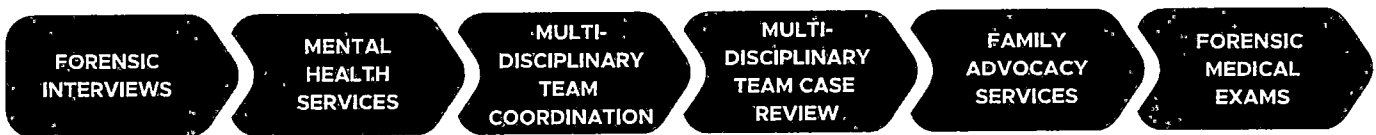

We exist to eliminate the negative outcomes associated with child abuse and to restore the full potential of the child.

Children's Advocacy Center for North Texas provides mental health care and specialized victim services to children aged 0-17 and their family members who have been traumatized by criminal levels of physical abuse, child fatalities, or sexual abuse. We do this by offering six core services in both English and Spanish at our locations in Lewisville, Denton, and Bridgeport. Therapy services also offered at our satellite office in Jacksboro.
