

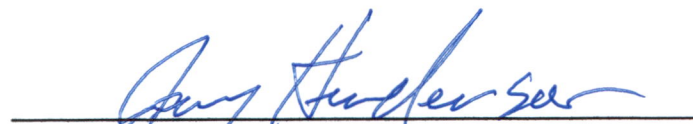
Jack County Commissioners Court:

Joining a functioning established organization just makes good business sense. Also, creating our own one-county groundwater district may not even be an option.

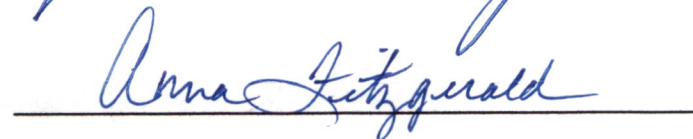
We recommend joining the Upper Trinity GCD as soon as possible.
